
Dear Mr. Gonzalez:

This is official notification that EIT: Excellence in Teaching has received the status of “**ACCREDITED-NOT RATED**” under the Accountability System for Educator Preparation (ASEP). This rating is provided to new educator preparation programs upon initial approval until the educator preparation program can be issued a status based on the performance standards. The educator preparation program is fully accredited and may recommend candidates for certification. The status is issued for the period from September 1, 2009, through August 31, 2010, by the State Board for Educator Certification (SBEC) under the authority of Texas Education Code Section 21.045.

Accreditation statuses are issued annually to each educator preparation program and are based on performance standards established by Senate Bill 174 and outlined in Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §229.
